Download blutwrp.img from here https://bluroms.info/modifedrecover\_ance-5-0-twrp/ Download SR5-SuperSU-v2.82-SR5-2017100124502.zip from here: https://download.chainfire.eu/1220/5\_retrieve\_file=1 Install ADB Enable Developer Options Enable USB Debugging and OEM Unlocking in developer options Plug in phone into USB Run "adb devices". If the phone is not listed in command output STOP here. Run "adb reboot bootloader" Run "fastboot devices". If the phone is not listed in command output STOP here. Run "fastboot oem unlock". Phone will ask you to say Yes/No. You need to say "Yes" to proceed. This will wipe the phone and all your data. Hit volume UP to proceed. Unplug and hit the button to Reboot the phone. WAIT!!! It will take a few minutes to it. If the phone gets stuck for over 10 minutes, force-reboot it, by holding Volume Up and power button for 10 seconds. Reboot the phone and go through setup after it is done: Run "adb reboot bootloader" Run "fastboot boot blutwrp.img". Because this image locked some phones I find it safer to just boot of it without replacing stock recovery. On phone, you should be asked to "Swipe right to allow modification". Do so. Run "adb push SR5-SuperSU-v2.82-SR5-2017100124502.zip /" On phone hit "Install". Hit "Go up a level", scroll down to find SR5-SuperSU-v2.82-SR5-2017100124502.zip and tap it. Swipe right again to install. Reboot the phone After the phone reboots remove potential malware: Start SuperSu app once. run "adb shell" once in shell: su (it might take a minute for the phone to ask you to grant permission. Do it!) mount -o rw,remount /system rm -rf /system/app/AdupsFotaReboot rm -rf /system/app/AdupsFota rm -rf /data/data/com.adups.fota rm -rf /data/data/com.adups.fotasysoper rm -rf /system/app/ignite rm -rf /data/data/com.dti.blu rm -rf /system/priv-app/BLUHelp rm -rf /data/data/com.warranteer.helper.blu rm -rf /system/priv-app/PreinstallProvider-utm\_source-utm\_campaign-oem\_BLU\_us rm -rf /data/data/com.opera.preinstall mount -o ro,remount,ro /system exit Unplug phone, disable USB debugging and that should be it.
