## Do AirTags work with Android?

If you use an Android and you're curious about Apple's AirTag, the good news is that some basic functionality is available but there are limitations. Here's what to expect from AirTag on Android:

### What you can do:

- **Scan a lost AirTag:** If you lost an AirTag, you can use your Android phone's Near Field Communication (NFC) feature to scan it. If the AirTag is in Lost Mode, this will pull up a web page with contact information.
- **Detect unknown AirTags:** Apple offers an app called Tracker Detect for Android, which helps you identify nearby AirTags that are not registered to you. This can be useful for ensuring your privacy and security.

### What you can't do:

- **Pair an Apple AirTag:** AirTags are designed to pair exclusively with Apple devices through the Find My network. On Android, you can't register or track your own AirTags.
- **Use advanced tracking features:** Real-time location updates and Precision Finding are only available on iOS devices.

For full functionality, AirTags are best suited for those within the Apple ecosystem. For your Android device, we've suggested some alternatives below.

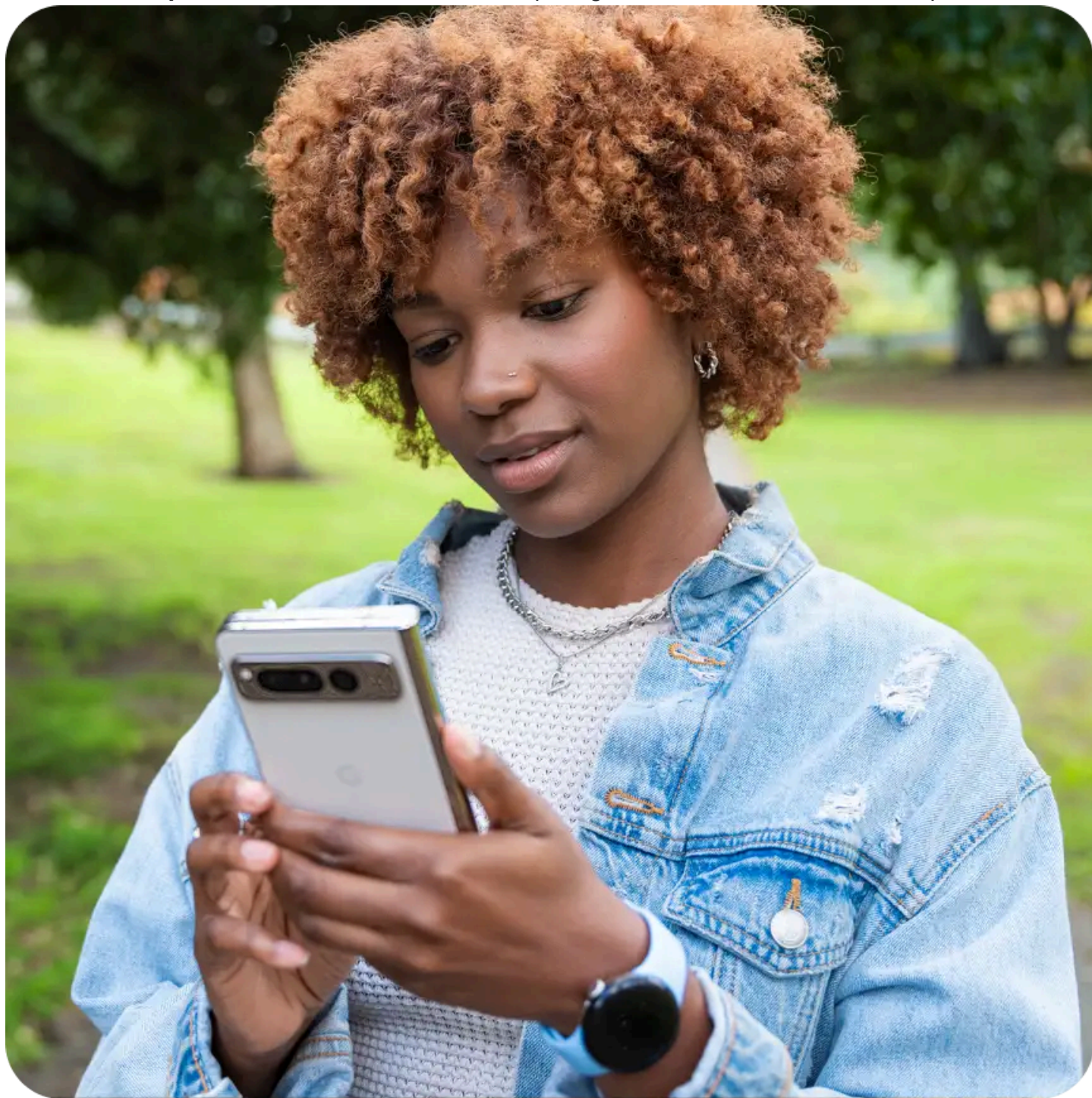
